L.A.-based saxophone artist George Shelby has been a Yamaha Artist since 1986. George has worked extensively with many of the world's top artists including Michael McDonald, Stevie Wonder, Larry Carlton and Boz Scaggs. He is a session player in Los Angeles and has played his saxophone on records and TV shows bought, listened to and seen by millions.

You will find his trademark soulful sound on shows like Glee, Bill Nye the Science Guy, Zula Patrol, Garfield the Movie, the Mask, and Robots. You can hear him on his feature commercial for Entertainment Tonight, American Idol (Star Academy in France), America's Got Talent, Good Morning America, with William Shatner on those Priceline.com ads and in promos for the ABC network. He has also performed with Barry Manilow, at the Academy Awards, at the People's Choice Awards, on Judging Amy, Late Night with David Letterman, Everybody Loves Raymond, and a host of other shows.

George Shelby's recording contributions include styles as diverse as Hilary Duff's, "Metamorphosis," to Bette Midler's, "Peggy Lee Tribute." Also Jacksoul, Lucy Pearl, Barry Manilow's "Greatest Songs of the Fifties," "The West Side Story Tribute," and many other recordings.

George proudly plays all Yamaha horns, including his Saxophones, Flutes, and Clarinets, in addition to his WX5 Wind Controller. He has toured the world as a clinician sharing his experiences and ideas with those looking to a career in music, and the casual player looking for some helpful hints. His documentary on making saxophones at the Yamaha factory continues to be one of the most viewed around the world.
